Basic Operators can:

- client test

Advanced Operators can:

- client test
- quality test
- conduct basic operator training sessions for Health Organisation/Service staff

Unless your role requires you to train others, we recommend enrolling first in Basic Operator training. Then, after you've obtained that level of competency, you can evaluate whether to upgrade to an Advanced Operator.

We suggest talking to your Health Organisation/Service Manager and/or Sexual Health Coordinators about this decision before you apply, and to obtain their authorisation of your request (as required in the application form).
